Evernote	Personal note-taking, having all your notes in one place.	Sharing and collaborating with other Evernote users can be clunky. Also they will try to sell you stuff.	60MB/month upload limit for Free accounts. Unlimited storage once stuff is uploaded. Google Drive	Sharing and collaborating on documents.	Documents must be shared with a Gmail/Google account- don't share to Hampshire email addresses!	16G as of this writing.	Free- but remember that you are not Google's customer- you are the product it sells to its customers (i.e. advertisers).
Zotero	Collecting and organizing items for research project.	Learning curve- but it's worth it!!	300MB	Free but you can buy more storage.
Trello	Organizing your life and work; to-do lists, prioritizing your tasks, group or individual project management.	None- for what it does, it's awesome.	10MB per file attachment, otherwise unlimited.	Free but they do offer business accounts and that kind of thing.
Google Calendar	Organizing your life and work; to-do lists, inviting other Google Calendar users to events.	Tasks feature is a little hard to find at first. Not as good as Trello for project or workload management.	N/A	See above- it's Google!
